St Andrews for Kids - This morning's session is about 'the Synagogue and the Upper Room'. The first part of this Godly Play presentation evokes the liturgy of the word, which the Christian church developed from the readings and the discussions about them in the Jewish synagogue. The second part of the presentation evokes the liturgy of the table, which Jesus instituted during the Last Supper in the upper room.
